PAUL W. MORRIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Paul W. Morris Memorial Scholarship Fund has been established under the sponsorship of The Salvation Army.

The Paul W. Morris Memorial Fund will be administered by a five-member committee consisting of The Salvation Army Advisory Board Chairman, The Salvation Army representative and three Advisory Council members who shall be appointed by the Chairman of The Salvation Army Advisory Council.

The Salvation Army Advisory Board will monitor the Paul W. Morris Memorial Fund periodically and publish the results as a part of their annual report.

The purpose of the fund shall be to provide financial assistance to students with demonstrable financial need and whose career goal is professional youth work.

The Scholarship Committee as designated above will be solely responsible for establishing the amount of the scholarship, reviewing applications and interviewing applicants for the scholarship award.

A student may be eligible for financial assistance from the scholarship fund if he/she is a graduate of a Wicomico County High School; is enrolled or accepted for enrollment in a college, university, or post-high school institution in preparation for a career assisting young persons; gives written evidence of financial need to continue his/her education; and submits an application for assistance with a recommendation from an Advisory Council member of The Salvation Army of Salisbury, or a Director of the Salvation Army professional staff.

The scholarship shall be renewable for a total of four years, provided the recipient is progressing satisfactorily towards graduation. The scholarship may not be renewed if the recipient is not progressing satisfactorily or is not exhibiting good moral character.

The award shall be paid directly to the institution of the student's choice and shall be used for payment of normal college expenses such as tuition, school fees, room and board.

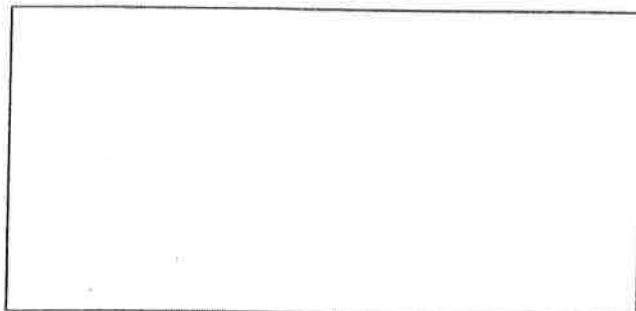
