APSAS Scholarship Guidelines

A. Eligibility for APSAS Scholarship

- 1. Recipient must have attended Wicomico County Public Schools for a period of at least two (2) years.
- 2. Recipient must be a resident of Wicomico County during his/her junior and senior years of high school.
- 3. Recipient must be a graduating senior of a Wicomico County high school.
- 4. Receipient must have a G.P.A of 3.0 or higher.

B. Conditions of APSAS Scholarship

- 1. The recipient may attend a college, university or technical school of his/her choice.
- 2. The scholarship shall be paid directly to the recipient.

C. Student nomination form

- 1. To be completed by the student
- 2. To be verified by the school counselor
- 3. Must contain
 - a. student resume
 - b. transcripts
 - c. 2 letters of reference

D. Selection of nominees

- 1. This scholarship will be available for four students (one from each county high school).
- 2. Maximum benefit will be \$500 per student.
- 3. All applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee.
- 4. Selection will be made on or before May 1.
