Richard L. Seay Memorial Scholarship Scholarship Award Guidelines

The Richard L. Seay Memorial Scholarship is awarded in memory of Rick Seay, a history teacher at Wicomico High School from 1994 until his passing in January of 2010.

- A. <u>Choice of School</u>: Accredited four-year college or university, or accredited two-year institution.
- B. Who May Apply: Graduating seniors of Wicomico High School, who have selected their college <u>and</u> have been accepted for admission as a <u>full-time</u> student.
- C. <u>Considerations</u>: Service-oriented, community involvement, academic achievement and extracurricular activities. Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- D. Nature of Award: Minimum of \$750 for one academic year.
- E. <u>How to Apply</u>: Applications are available at Wicomico High School guidance office. Completed applications must be submitted to the Wicomico High School Guidance office no later than April 18 of the current school year to be eligible for fall semester assistance. An application is complete, and considered for a scholarship award, only when the following have been submitted:
 - 1. A completed scholarship application
 - 2. Letter of acceptance from college or university
 - 3. Two letters of recommendation from non-family members (e.g. teacher, guidance counselor, employers, athletic coach, etc.)
