

## Jeffrey Morris Smith Scholarship Guidelines

An annual scholarship of \$1,000 or more as the income allows will be awarded once a year to a graduating senior of a Wicomico County high school, who is a member of a golf team and who has demonstrated outstanding concern for the school community, the broader community or his/her fellow students.

- A. Who May Apply: Graduating seniors at any of the four Wicomico County high schools who are members of the golf team who have been accepted for full time admission at a two or 4 year college or university.
- B. a four Qualifications:
1. A 3.0 grade point average in appropriate course work indicating the student is able to do college level work.
  2. A member of the Golf Team in junior and senior years.
  3. Active in civic and church activities.
- C. Nature of Award: \$1,000 or more as the income allows. Scholarship winner may apply for renewal and will be compared to all other candidates.
- D. How to Apply: Applications are available at Wicomico County High School counseling offices or by calling the office of the Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore (410) 742-9911. An application is complete, and considered for a scholarship award, only when the following have been submitted:
1. A one page essay with a golf related theme.
  2. A completed scholarship application.
  3. Official high school transcript of grades.
  4. Letter of acceptance from college or university.
  5. Two letters of recommendation from non-family members (e.g. teacher, guidance counselor, employer, athletic coach, etc.)
  6. Applicant may be required to be interviewed by the scholarship committee.
