

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP Guidelines

Academic scholarships offered by Wor-Wic Community College are awarded to academically talented senior applicants from the ten listed public high schools and the four listed private high schools in Wicomico, Worcester and Somerset counties.

A. Application Process and Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicants must complete an application for admission while enrolled in their junior or senior year at a qualified high school.
2. Applicants must complete the academic scholarship application and submit a high school transcript (through mid-senior year) to the financial aid office by the application date. The transcript should clearly indicate the applicant's Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.
3. Awardees must be residents of Wicomico, Worcester, or Somerset counties at the time of application and through the duration of their award.
4. Applicants are required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for all local need-based scholarships.

B. Application Deadline

The application deadline is **April 3, 2017.**

C. Award Selection Process

1. After each year's deadline, applicants will be ranked according to Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as determined by the FAFSA.
2. Additionally, applicants will be evaluated on their high school GPA based on a 4.0 scale.
3. Upon award completion, the financial aid office will notify recipients and make arrangements through the admissions office for a Wor-Wic Community College representative to attend the awards presentation at the respective awardee's high school.

D. Declined and/or Unused Awards

1. In the event that an academic scholarship recipient declines in writing or fails to enroll during the fall semester following their award, the award and commitment are forfeited and de-obligated.
2. In the event that a recipient fails to enroll in consecutive fall and spring semesters, the award and commitment are forfeited and de-obligated.
