

BOARD OF TRUSTEES SCHOLARSHIP Guidelines

The Board of Trustees Scholarships are the most prestigious scholarships offered by Wor-Wic Community College, awarded to the most academically talented senior applicant from the ten listed public high schools and two of the listed private high schools in Wicomico, Worcester, and Somerset counties.

A. Application Process and Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicants must complete an application for admission while enrolled in their junior or senior year at a qualified high school.
2. Applicants must complete the Board of Trustees scholarship application and submit a high school transcript (through mid-senior year) to the financial aid office by the application date. The transcript should clearly indicate a minimal 3.25 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale.
3. Awardees must be residents of Wicomico, Worcester, or Somerset counties at the time of application and through the duration of their award.

B. Application Deadline

The application deadline is **April 3, 2017**.

C. Award Selection Process

1. After each year's deadline, applicants from each public high school will be ranked according to the highest GPA, total number of credits earned, and earliest submission date of the Wor-Wic Community College admission application. The one (1) student with the highest GPA overall from each school will receive the Board of Trustees scholarship.
2. After each year's deadline, applicants from the participating private high schools are ranked according to highest GPA, total number of credits earned, and earliest submission date of the Wor-Wic Community College admission application. The student with the highest GPA among all the eligible private high schools will receive a Board of Trustees scholarship. The student with the next highest GPA from a different eligible private high school will receive a Board of Trustees scholarship.
3. In the event of equal GPAs, the student with the highest total number of credits earned will receive the award and, in the event of equal GPAs and total number of high school credits earned, the student with the earliest admission application will receive the award.
4. Upon award completion, the financial aid office will notify recipients and make arrangements through the admissions office for a Wor-Wic Community College representative to attend the awards presentation at the awardee's high school.

D. Declined and/or Unused Awards

1. In the event that an academic scholarship recipient declines in writing or fails to enroll during the fall semester following their award, the award and commitment are forfeited and de-obligated.
2. In the event that a recipient fails to enroll in consecutive fall and spring semesters, the award and commitment are forfeited and de-obligated.

E. Continuation of Award

The Board of Trustees scholarship requires awardees to maintain a college GPA of at least 3.00. Awardees who enroll in consecutive fall/spring semesters and maintain a GPA above 3.00 will receive the two-year full tuition scholarship of up to 70 credit hours. If the recipient fails to maintain a 3.00 GPA or fails to enroll in consecutive fall/spring semesters, the award and commitment are forfeited and de-obligated. Students are permitted to enroll in summer sessions.
