**DESCRIPTION**

Friends and family members of the late Kristin Rendine established an endowed scholarship fund for **early childhood education** students at Wor-Wic. The daughter of Paul and Nancy Rendine of Salisbury and a 2000 general studies graduate, Kristin ultimately wanted to become a teacher. She re-enrolled to complete a degree in early childhood education, but she did not live long enough to achieve her goal. Income from the endowment is used for the annual scholarships. Selection is based on scholastic achievement and an essay submitted to the human services department head. Recipients must maintain a 3.00 grade point average. The award for the 2015-16 academic year is \$1,000.
