- Be physically qualified by Marine Corps standards
- · Have no criminal record of military or civilian offenses
- Score of 74 or higher on the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery Test (ASVAB) or achieve a qualifying score on the American College Test (ACT) or the Scholastic Aptitude Test
- Apply and gain admission to one of the 3 HSIs listed
