Wicomico Economic Impact Scholarship Guidelines

The WEIS scholarship offered by Wor-Wic Community College can be awarded to senior applicants from the six listed public high schools and the two listed private high schools in Wicomico County.

Public High Schools:

Private High Schools:

Salisbury School
Salisbury Christian School

A. Application Process and Eligibility Criteria

The Wicomico Economic Impact Scholarship (WEIS) was created by Wicomico County to provide free tuition and fees for new high school graduates, and for those completing the General Education Development (GED) or National External Diploma Program (NEDP). Students that maintain eligibility can participate in the scholarship program for six continuous semesters, or until they receive one associate degree. New high school students are eligible for the scholarship if they have:

- a) been a resident of Wicomico County for at least the past two years
- b) attended a public, private or home school in Wicomico County for at least the past two years (Wicomico residents who attended Delmar High School are also eligible)
- c) have an average household income of \$75,000 or less as reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- d) completed all high school graduation requirements
- e) applied for admission into a degree or certificate program at Wor-Wic
- f) completed the application process for all federal, state and institutional financial aid and a WEIS Application
- g) ensured that their final official high school transcripts have been received by Wor-Wic's admissions office
- h) registered for 12 or more credit hours (or fewer only if required in a specific academic program) at Wor-Wic in the fall term immediately after graduating from high school, and
- i) attended a WEIS orientation session before the fall term begins.

B. Application Deadline

The application deadline is **June 1, 2018.**

C. WEIS Eligibility Process

1. Upon review of completed application & required materials, Wor-Wic's financial aid office will notify recipients.
